

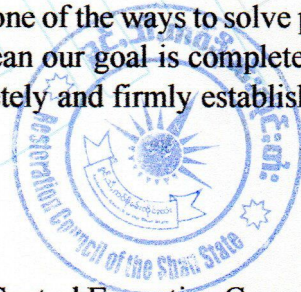

Statement on the 63rd Anniversary of the Shan State People Resistance Day

Date: 21 May 2021

1. Shan State People Resistance Day, which falls on 21st May of each year, is an important day that recognizes and honours the patriotic spirit of the resistance fighters. On this day, religious ceremonies are held to make merit and pray for the officers and soldiers, who have sacrificed their lives while fighting for our national cause in the resistance war, to attain better existence in their next lives.
2. From this 63rd Anniversary of the Shan State People Resistance Day onward, we will continue to wage the resistance war in accordance with our noble principles – Nation, Country, Language and Religion - until we achieve our goal.
